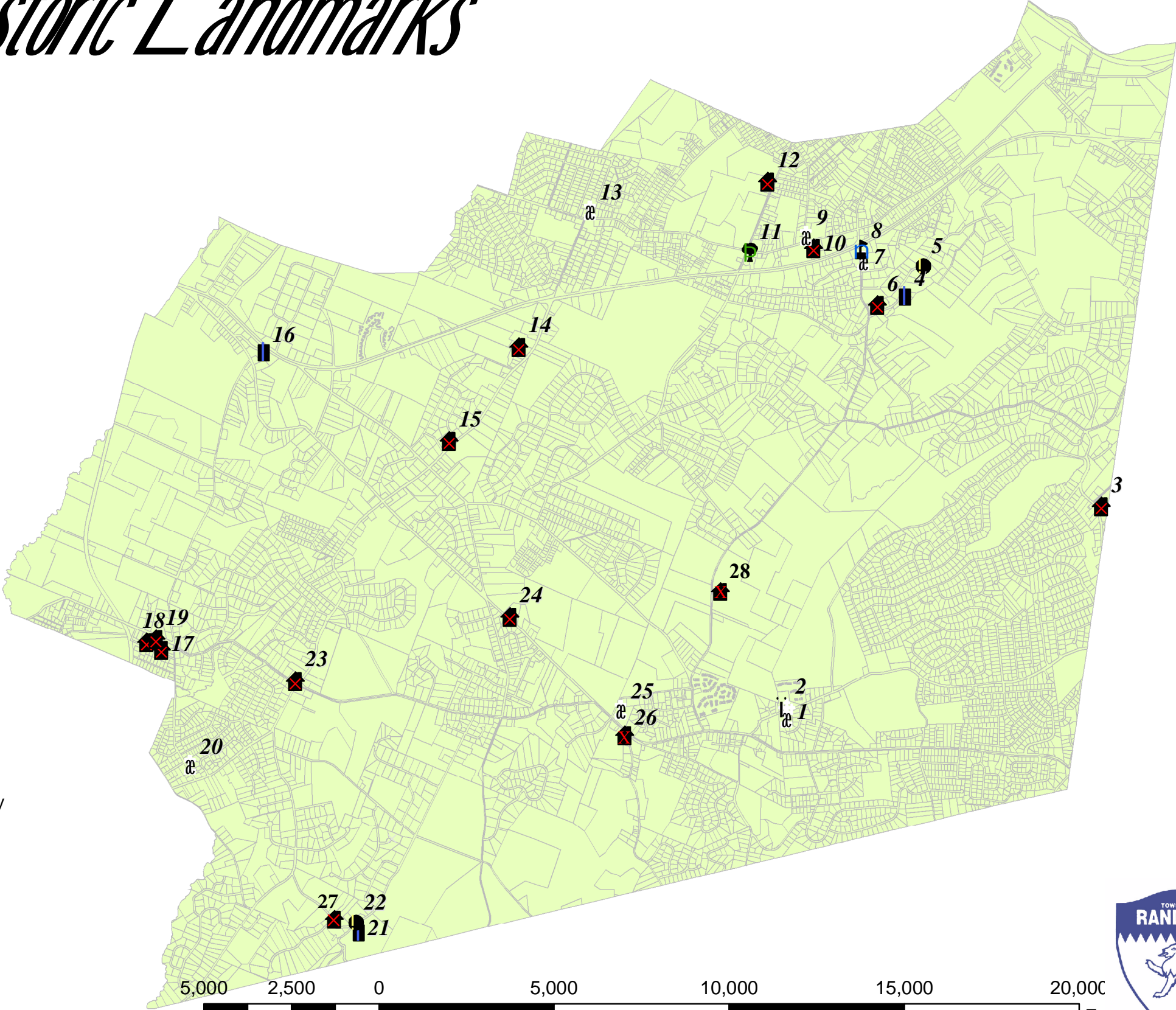

- Mott Davenport Grist Mill 72 Gristmill Road C. 1798
- Mott Hollow Historic district - Millbrook Avenue and Gristmill Road along the Mill Brook, 1800. Also on NJ and National Register.
- David Tuttle Cooperage, 83 Gristmill Road, C. 1812 (also National and N.J. Registers of Historic Places)
- Millbrook Methodist Church 246 Millbrook Avenue, 1833
- Millbrook School, S.E. Corner of (236) Millbrook Ave. and Route 10 - 1924
- Randolph Friends Meeting House, Quaker Church Road and Quaker Avenue, 1758 (also National and N.J. Registers of Historic Places)
- Searing Cooper House, 189 Quaker Church Road, C. 1840
- Liberty Tree at Dell's Corner, S.E. Corner of Quaker Church and Center Grove Road, White Oak, C. 1720
- Brotherton House (Evergreen Cottage), 52 Center Grove Road, 1876
- Mt. Fern United Methodist Church, 448 Quaker Church and Dover Chester Roads, 1883
- Moses Sayre Sr. House, 124 Dover Chester Road, C. 1813
